My sister is at death's door. The doctor is trying to pull her through.

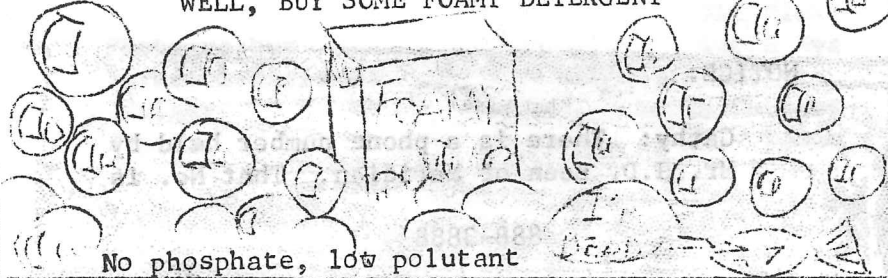

BOOKBINDING AS A CAREER

There are many wide-spread opportunities open to the bookbinder. Most people feel that working in a bindershop with other workers (5) is simply humdrum while others think it is just boreful, but in reality there are many varied and exciting jobs open. For instance: have you ever considered getting a job in a bindry dept. of a large book, periodical, or commercial art printing plant? Well, if this still isn't your binding bag, maybe you would prefer the specific

repairs department in an assembly line at a large library. In a large town. Perhaps you would like to operate alarge complicated, manual operated sewing repairing corners, or maybe you would like to repair backs (if you like hospital work). Maybe you dig pages. There are many jobs available at your nearby junk yard. Training and other qualifications are: a four or five year apprenticeship which includes on-the-job training and related classroom instruction. This is generally required to qualify as a skilled bookbinder. Wherefore, unskilled occupations: the training may last a few months or a few years. Put it in a place where you can see it every day. Work constantly at improving your good points and accomplishing your goals.
