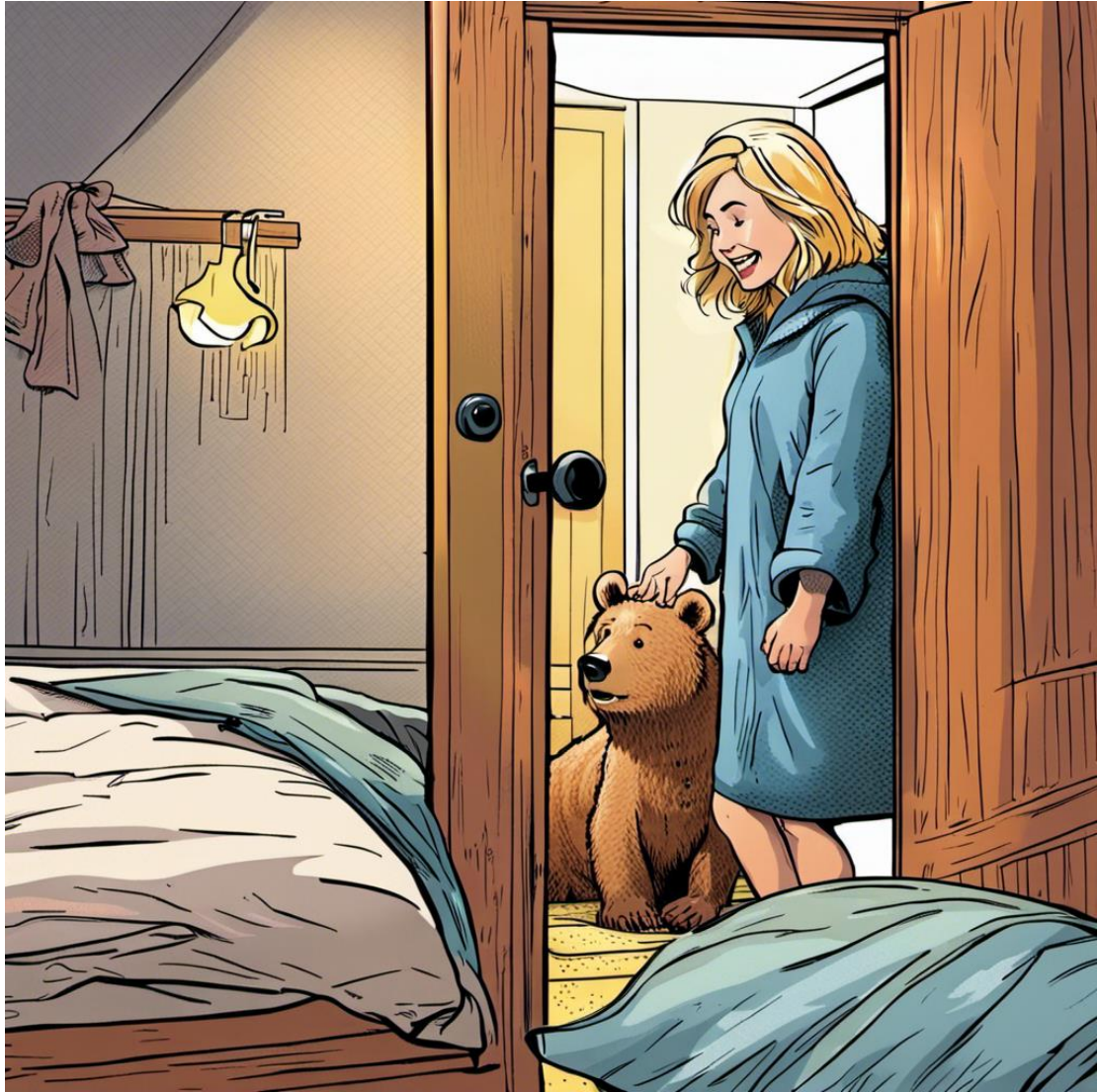
A Secret in the Bedroom

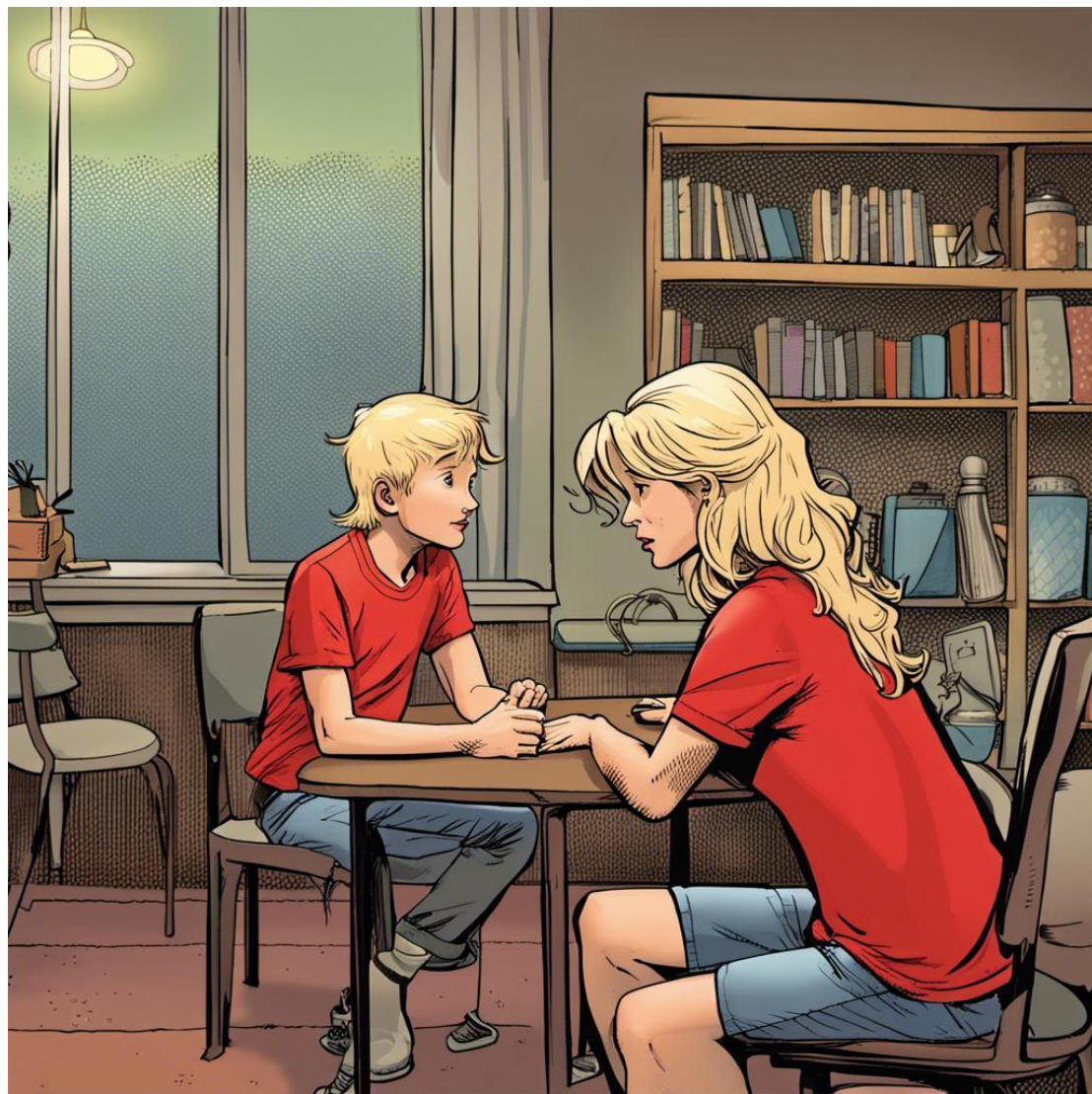
Mom's Surprise

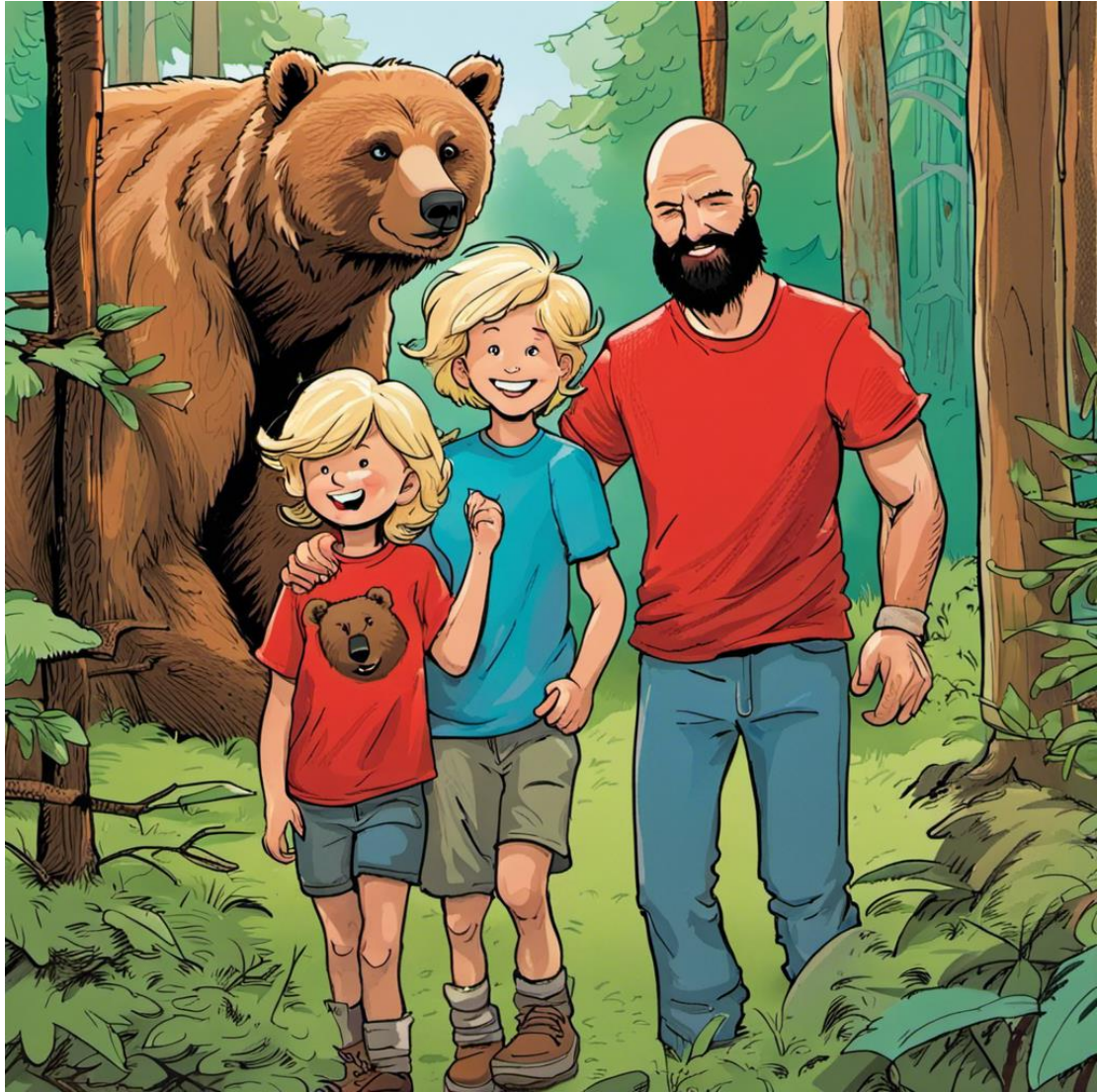
A Decision to Make
